### INTRODUCTION

Africa, as many developing Countries in Asia, Latin America and Eastern Europe have done, has over the past few decades invested heavily in infrastructure. The decisions to invest in specific major infrastructural projects have been quite often well intended as good quality infrastructure is a key factor to sustainable development. An efficient transport, sanitation, energy and communication systems are critically needed if Africa is to prosper and provide an acceptable standard of living for its citizens. However, most African countries do not have the right infrastructure which can promote their growth and ability to trade in the global economy. Related to the infrastructure challenges, is to make major infrastructure investment translate to social-economic benefits to the citizenry.
